## Dolomites UNESCO World Heritage



The unspoilt Villnöss valley with the Geisler/Odle peaks lies in the heart of the Dolomites UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Dolomites are among the most beautiful mountain landscapes in the world. In 2009, UNESCO recognised their uniqueness, their geological and geomorphological importance and of course their beauty when they declared the Dolomites a World Heritage Site. Inclusion on the world heritage list is the world's highest form of recognition for a natural site, a sort of Nobel Prize for natural assets. Of course, this award is also connected with a great responsibility. The goal is the preservation and protection of this priceless asset.

## Slow Food Travel Villnöss valley

In the authentic Villnöss valley, the farming culture and sustainability can be perceived through the lifestyle of the local population. The **wide range of activities and culinary delights** using local produce offer ideal conditions for nature lovers seeking deceleration in the midst of the mountain world.

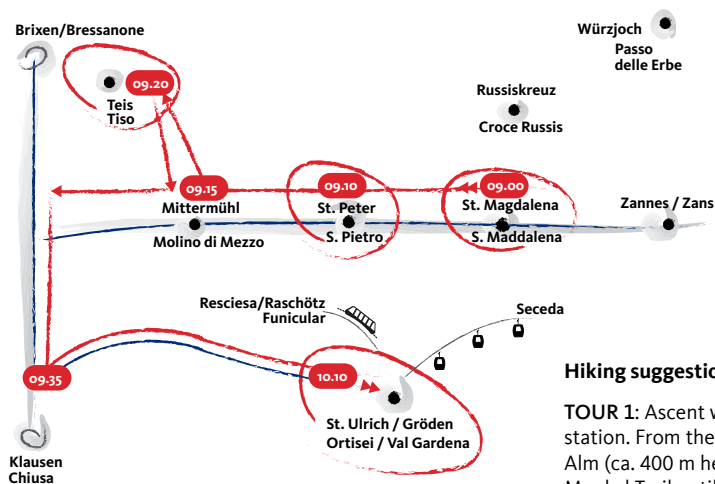

**TOUR 1:** Ascent with the Seceda cable car until the middle station. From there walk on trail no. 5 leading to hut Brogles Alm (ca. 400 m height difference). Continue on the Adolf Munkel Trail until reaching the meadows of Gschnagenhardt (no. 35 & 34) and via the hut Dusleralm to Zans (no. 36). Alternatively, you can also descend from the hut Brogles Alm via trail no. 28 to Ranui.

**TOUR 2:** Ascent with the funicular Resciesa. From there via trail no. 35 to the hut Brogles Alm. Continue via the Adolf Munkel Trail to Zans (no. 35 & 6). Alternatively, you can also descend from the hut Brogles Alm via trail no. 28 to Ranui.

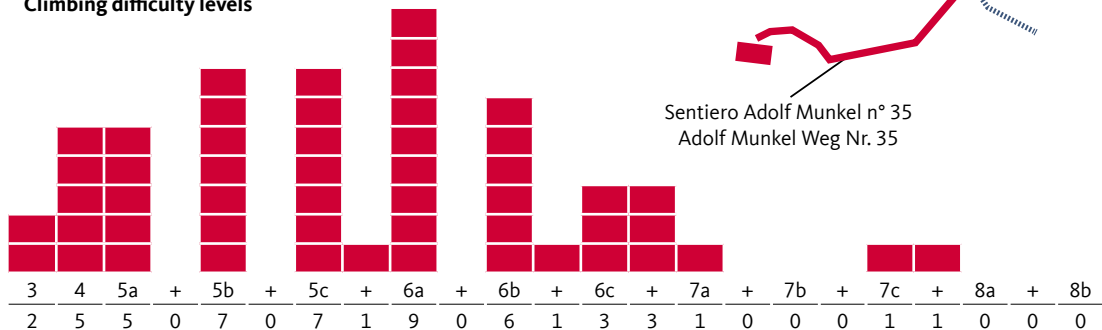
## Climbing area near the Adolf-Munkel-Trail and at Würzjoch/Passo delle Erbe

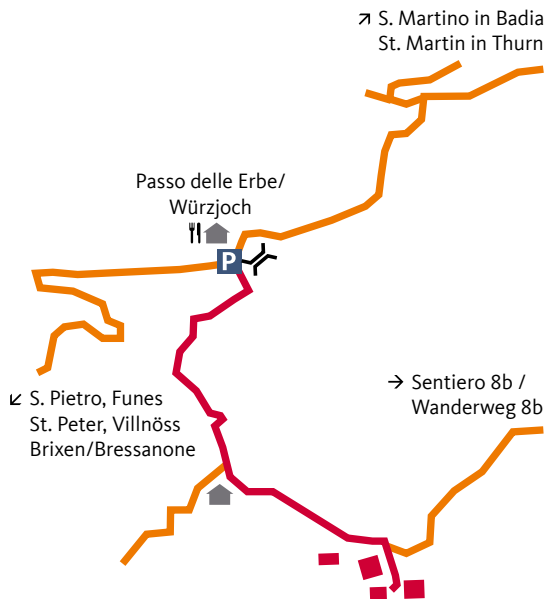




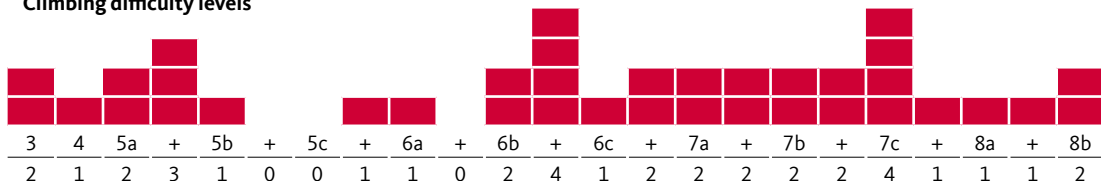


## How to get to the climbing area Würzjoch/Passo delle Erbe

## Attractions

### Traditional chapels

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Chapels on the Felthun, Urban, Gsoi, Lippmös and Miglanz farms, as well as beneath the Flitzer Jöchl, are proof of the religious importance of farms in days gone by.

### St. Michael Chapel of Pitzack

---

The unique tabernacle is particularly interesting: the Cross is made from a vine.

### Nafen church (1307)

---

High Gothic church, dedicated to St. Bartholomew, with a remarkable winged altar.

### Church of St. Magdalena (1394)

---

First mentioned in 1394, the late Gothic church that we see today, with its asymmetrical net vault, was built in 1492. The Saint Christopher fresco on the south wall dates back to the 16<sup>th</sup> century. The interior has a Baroque influence with paintings by the Ladin artist, Johann M. Pescoller (1928).

*The access road to the church is closed for cars (gate) and only accessible to residents. It is best to park at the "Putzen" car park shortly after the village St. Magdalena and walk to the church (approx. 30 min.).*

### St. Jakob am Joch Church (about 1500)

Close to Tschaufris' burnt offering site St. Jakob am Joch, with its 12<sup>th</sup> century nave wall, stands upon an ancient path. The present construction dates back to 1500. The precious winged altar from 1517 is a particular highlight, crafted by Ruprecht Potsch and Philipp Diemer.

### The small church of St. John of Nepomuk in Ranui (1744)

World famous and much photographed subject. The tiny church, founded in 1744 by the mine owner, Michael von Jenner, is nestled in Attractions extraordinary countryside. The altar paintings by Franz Sebald Unterberger (1706–1776) from the Fleim Valley are particularly noteworthy.

**The church is privately owned and the access is subject to a fee.**

### Pestbildstöckl (wayside shrine against the plague)

Brick shrine on the way to St. Magdalena.

### Parish church of Teis/Tiso (1890)

Church in Neo-Gothic style, dedicated to the sacred Heart of Jesus. Statues and altars were crafted by Val Gardena woodcarvers.

### Parish church of St. Peter and Paul

Classical church, built in the 18th century by the master builder, Matthäus Wachter from Bolzano, with an impressive tower dated 1897. The late Baroque ceiling paintings are the work of Joseph Schöpf, one of the Tirol's greatest painters.

### Church of St. Valentin

The foundation walls of the church date back to 1303. The bell tower is Romanesque with a stone, pyramid-shaped pinnacle.

### Holy Sepulchre Chapel

The Holy Sepulchre Chapel was built in the late 17<sup>th</sup> century in Baroque style. The chapel has a polygonal structure, taken from the famous Church of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem. Inside is still a sculpture of the body of Christ and sorrowful Mother of God. The Holy Sepulchre Hill, also called Mount Calvary, is one of the most beautiful lookout point of Teis/Tiso.

# Mineral Museum Teis/Tiso

## Geodes of Teis

The Mineral Museum is located in the centre of Teis/Tiso in the Villnöss valley. It has been designed according to modern aspects of museum education and offers a staggering as well as informative exhibition. Besides the famous Geodes of Teis, the exhibition also features minerals from other Alpine regions visited by Paul Fischnaller in order to expand his collection.

An introductory film provides even non-experts with a comprehensive overview of the origin and nature of the minerals displayed in the museum. Every single one of the exhibits was found by Paul Fischnaller and none of them were bought or traded. The exhibition is constantly being enhanced with new, interesting pieces by Paul Fischnaller.

The museum shop offers a wide choice of literature on the subject as well as souvenirs, jewellery and healing stones.

**Geodes of Teis** can measure up to 20 cm in diameter.

The geodes as well as the almond-shaped agates are embedded in their andesite bedrock. Up to seven different beautifully crystallised minerals can be found inside these “druses”. This makes the Geodes of Teis unique in the world. Amethyst and quartz crystals stand out due to their transparent purity, as does agate with its almost geometric rings. Every geode contains its own little secret “crystal garden” which you can explore in the museum.

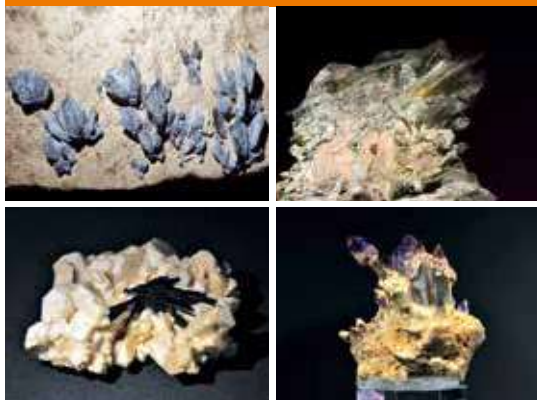

## Puez-Geisler Nature Park House

The Puez-Geisler Nature Park House in St. Magdalena in Villnöss valley has set itself the task of bringing nature closer to visitors and to invite them to linger. After all, the world’s most famous alpinist Reinhold Messner comes from Villnöss valley. In a short film he talks about his experiences in the mountains. ## Dolomites UNESCO World Heritage - Info Point Zans

**Astonishment:** There is nothing better describing the Dolomites than this feeling. Marvel at their beauty, their audacity, at a masterpiece of nature. It took 270 million years to make it. In the info point, they will be traversed in time-lapse - up to the present day, where the Dolomites are "UNESCO World Heritage". The exhibition, which entertains visitors, informs them and makes them smile, also shows what lies behind it. And of course amaze.

Beauty outlasts all time. But sometimes it is the time that creates beauty. It has taken millions of years for the Dolomites to be modelled by monumental master builders: by earth plates, volcanoes, oceans, glaciers, ice, water, wind. No wonder, then, that one feels so small in front of such a miracle of nature, and that the feeling that arises watching these mountains is an astonishment that cannot be compared with anything else. This exhibition about the Dolomites describes the development and existence of this landscape, whose "extraordinary beauty and geological peculiarity" made it UNESCO World Heritage in 2009. A beauty that will last forever.

## The Trenches of Teis/Tiso in the Villnöss valley

**Around the village of Teis, from the bottom of the Villnöss valley to the Haube mountain at 1260 m above sea level, you can find a line of partly uncovered and partly hidden trenches, shelters and caverns. These are the remains of the extensive fortifications built as part of the “Barricade of Klausen/Chiusa” at the beginning of the First World War.**

Shortly after the beginning of the First World War, by order of the Defence Command of Tyrol of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, the construction of field fortifications began north of Klausen, at the narrowest part of the Eisacktal valley. These fortifications were meant to protect the area against a possible invasion by Italian troops if the Dolomites front had fallen and troops had entered the area of Bolzano/Bozen.

From November 1914, trenches, shelters and caverns had been built on the hills around Teis, from the bottom of the Villnöss valley up to 1260 m above sea level. These fortifications were additionally protected by barbed wire fencing. At the end of June 1915, after only seven months of construction, the workers were recalled because they were needed in the defensive fortifications of the 1<sup>st</sup> line. However, by that time, “defensive capability” of the fortifications around Teis had “almost been reached.”

Since the front at the southern border of Tyrol held until the end of the war, these fortifications never saw any actual combat. They were however used as training bases during their construction and the war.

Over the course of the last century, the trenches have been partly destroyed by human activities and partly reclaimed by nature.

A group of locals has taken on the task of investigating the history of these fortifications more closely, preserving them and making them accessible to the public.

Two well-preserved and freely accessible trenches with caverns are within a short hiking distance from the village centre.

## Mobilcards

The **Mobilcard** allows you to explore South Tyrol on one, three or seven consecutive days using the “altoadige-mobilità” public transport network. You may purchase your Mobilcard at any South Tyrol Integrated Transport ticket office, as well as at tourist offices and museums. They are personal and non-transferable tickets. Children up to the age of 6 travel for free.

### Validation methods:

The new **contactless cards** must be validated before every journey by approaching the sensor of the blue obliterating machine. The expiry date appears on the display.

### Included in the network are:
